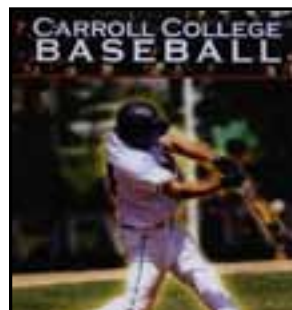

PITCHING

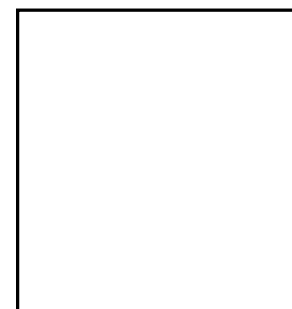

Chris Bosio, former Major League pitcher for the Milwaukee Brewers and Seattle Mariners and current Major League pitching coach will be conducting private lessons and hosting large and small group camps and clinics at Players Choice of the Fox Cities from October 12, 2009 to January 31, 2010. Chris Bosio posted a career 94-93 record, striking out 1,059 batters, posting a 3.96 ERA and throwing a no-hitter on April 22, 1993 (The last no-hitter thrown by a Mariner).

After retiring from playing, Bosio began a career in coaching with the Seattle Mariners as their Special Assignment pitching coach and then with the Tampa Bay Devil Rays as their Big League pitching coach. Bosio then became the Assistant Coach in charge of the pitchers for UW Oshkosh and later Lawrence University before getting back into professional ball for the Cincinnati Reds and their Double-A affiliate the Chattanooga Lookouts. Later, he was asked to come back to his original team, the Milwaukee Brewers, where he was in their farm system coaching before he spent much of 2009 with the Triple-A Nashville Sounds before replacing Brewers pitching
