Was a member of the '02 AAA Legion State Champion Appleton Rebels earning MVP award after hitting (.591) and going 2-0 on the mound striking out 26. College career at Madison College from '03-'04 setting records in innings pitched in a season (84), innings pitched in a career (145.1) and finishing second all time in career strikeouts (137). Transferred to UW-Milwaukee where he tied Milwaukee records for best winning percentage in a season winning 7 games in a row and finished third in strikeout/walk ratio (3.47) in school history. Finished senior season with an 8-2 record earning him second team All-Horizon League honors. Rick also starred in the Northwood's League in the summers of 2003, '04 and '05 with the Mankato Moon Dogs' and Wisconsin Woodchucks.
