Before going to Green Bay, Roberts was the head coach at Denmark High School for three years, compiling at 51-19 record. Roberts is still an active pitcher at the open level. His accolades include two ASA national titles, and ISF Jr. World Title, eight New Zealand national titles, NAFA triple A North American title and Australian State title. In addition, Roberts has pitched in 13 ISC World Tournaments and was a member of the ISF Samoan men’s national team. Roberts was a two-time ASA All-American and a NAFA All-American. Roberts has multiple American and New Zealand MVP pitching awards including the New Zealand Herald Junior Sports Award which is awarded to the top five junior prospects in New Zealand Sport.

A graduate of Kimberly High School, Cara was a 4 year starter in both the infield and outfield. Cara went on to be a four-year starter as a first baseman at UW-La Crosse. In her final season at La Crosse, she led the Eagles to a 16-0 WIAC Conference Championship as well as the WIAC Tournament Championship. She earned a 1st Team All-Conference selection in the WIAC and a 3rd Team All-Great Lakes Region selection while starting all 47 games for the Eagles. Cara ranks 1st in school history in career homeruns and career RBI, and is also tied for 1st in single season RBI. Cara has been a youth tournament team softball coach since 2008.
